Aim of training

This two-day workshop aims to provide participants with a basic understanding of mental illness, how to recognize potential signs and how to support students who are struggling to manage stress at home and school. Everyone is susceptible to developing mental health issues when they are under stress and don't have the coping mechanisms or resources to handle pressure. It is often difficult for young students to talk openly about their feelings because of the stigma related to mental illness. Learning to spot the early warning signs and providing support to vulnerable students is essential in accessing early treatment options.

CHCCCS016 Respond to client needs provides participants with the knowledge and skills required to assess a range of client issues and refer appropriately

CHCMHS001 Work with people with mental health issues provides participants a person-centred approach to care, involving a variety of health and community service professionals working collaboratively with the client, their carer/s and family
