Subject to requests for information meeting appropriate thresholds, ISEs can and must share with the following ISEs under the CISS and FVISS and MARAM framework organisations:

## Phase 2 ISEs – commencing in 2021

Phase Two of the Child Information Sharing Scheme (CISS), the Family Violence Information Sharing Scheme (FVISS) and the Family Violence Multi-Agency Risk Assessment and Management Framework (MARAM) was to commence for schools, early childhood education and care services, community mental health services, general practitioners and public hospitals in September 2020.

Due to coronavirus (COVID-19) and to support the critical role educators and universal health services play in Victoria, the commencement of Phase Two of the reforms will be delayed and is proposed to commence in the first half of 2021.

Subject to consultation, in 2021 the following additional organisations and services are likely to be authorised under the 3 reforms:
